Charlotte, N.C.-April 30, 2013 – The Humane Society of Charlotte will be the host for two international veterinary interns involved in animal advocacy abroad as part of Humane Society International's Expo Internship Program. The goal is to encourage and promote training in all aspects of daily shelter/society operations and spay/neuter programs.

**Danai Markaki from Heraklion, Greece**, is a veterinarian with many years' experience in companion animal rescue work who is extremely involved in projects focusing on long term, sustainable solutions for problems affecting various species of animals. She is employed by Heraklion Municipal Shelter, a temporary shelter facility for dogs as they go through a Catch/Neuter/Release or Adopt Program. She also works for the small, nonprofit organization, Cretan Animal Welfare Society, on their subsidized neutering project.

**Sara Luisa Sousa Grosso from Maputo Province, Mozambique**, is responsible for all animal healthcare and spay/neuter surgery for the Mozambique Animal Protection Society. She specializes in managing animal welfare education programs for children between the ages of 6 and 12 and leads Rabies vaccination and sterilization campaigns in coordination with the local government for Maputo Province and surrounding areas.
