





Who We Are

A community resource committed to improving the lives of companion animals through adoption, spay/neuter and education.

A private 501(c)(3) non-profit organization with a \$3.1 million operating budget that receives no federal, state, or local funding. We rely solely on private donations and foundation grants to achieve our vision of all animals in safe and loving homes.

What We Do

We average 120-150 animals on site at our shelter or in foster care and available for adoption at any given time.

In 2013 our iFoster program gave care to 2,168 animals. For information on this program visit hscifoster.org.

We started our iCare rehoming program in September 2013, allowing pet owners to rehome their pets without surrendering to the shelter. We have had 3 cats and 8 dogs rehomed through this program.

Placed 2,715 dogs and cats in their new forever homes in 2013, an average of a more than 52 per week.

Our HSC-superdog training program held 225 sessions and had 260 dogs graduate. For information visit hscsuperdog.org.

Adoption fees range from fee waived adult cat adoptions to kitten, puppy and dog adoptions ranging from \$125 to \$175 which include veterinary and behavior screening/testing, spay/neuter surgery, all vaccinations, a microchip and 30 days of pet insurance. Adoption promotions take place throughout the year and many include fee waived and discounted adoption fees.

Performed 11,113 spay/neuter surgeries in 2013 at our two spay/neuter clinics. Since the clinic opened in 1982, we have altered over 250K animals and prevented billions of unwanted births.

Spay/Neuter fees range from \$30 to \$75 (the lowest cost around) and these services are available for pet owners in any state or county.

HSC's Critter Care Wednesday Wellness Clinic administered 8,419 vaccines to 2,406 animals; in addition, 2,406 animals were microchipped.

Our Community Outreach team performed 72 spay/neuter transports with 1,708 animals.

Approximately 1,517 animals were fed through our HSC pet food bank, where we distributed over 16,000 pounds of food to those in need.
