

Fast Facts



We re-homed **2,724** pets in their new loving homes. **1,554** dogs and **1,170** cats.



Our shelter vet staff performed over **4,000** medical exams. These included treatments for a variety of health concerns.



Over **92** dogs and cats benefitted from medical incentives to help cover their cost for dental and/or heartworm treatments.



We performed **12,574** spay/neuter surgeries at our two spay/neuter clinics. Our fees range from \$35 - \$85 (the lowest cost around).



Our Community Cats (TNR) program has enabled us to humanely trap, neuter or spay, and return **3,037** community (feral) cats.



Our Spay/Neuter Clinic team assisted **5,169** clients at their weekly **Critter Care Wellness Clinic**, HSC's low-cost, high quality vaccine and microchip clinic.



As part of our Community Outreach, our team provided services for **329** animals.



HSC Volunteers donated **15,484** hours of their time in 2017. In addition, HSC iFosters donated **26,567** hours caring for animals in their homes.



We distributed over **54,590** lbs of food to over **802** pets through our Pet Food Bank.



Our Pets For Life (PFL) program assisted 465 animals with various needs including emergency medical services, spay/neuter surgeries, and boarding.



Our iBuild program completed **9** fences and provided **201** tarps to help keep dogs cool and dry during the summer, and over **244** bales of straw to keep dogs warm and cozy during the winter.



We took in **1,011** animals from owner surrenders and **1,639** animals from municipal shelters, including our community partner CMPD Animal Care & Control.
