- Provide our community with low cost behavior support for their pets




ANIMAL INTAKE

Year-to-date: Over 1500
 animals have come into
 our care through transfer
 & owner surrenders

 At start of COVID-19 we saw a 36% increase in community requests to surrender their animal




ANIMAL INTAKE




- During the Stay-At-Home Order:
 31% decrease in intake
- Since stay at home order has entered phase one and two, intake has steadily begun to rise again

ADOPTIONS IN COVID-19

- Staff & Public Safety are a top priority
- Normal walk in same-day adoptions have been suspended
 - Adoption by Appointment
 - Adoption Ambassador
- Social Distancing and use of a face covering are required for all staff and the public
- All staff interacting with the public undergo wellness screen and temperature checks



FOSTER



- Since the start of COVID-19
 - HSC has generated over 225 new foster homes
 - Placed over 550 unique animals into foster homes
 - 250 kittens have entered our care in the past two months

BEHAVIOR & PET HELP

- During Stay-at-Home order we suspended public group training classes
- Our behavior team conducted 150 private training assessments reducing pet surrender significantly during this time
- We have now re-launched public group training classes geared towards helping people and their pets adapt to this new world as a result of COVID-19




Priority # 3: Re-Starting Spay/Neuter



VOLUNTEER PROGRAM

- Has been closed since the pandemic happened but slowly opening some positions
- Focused on engaging volunteers during the shut down of the program
- Currently no new volunteers are accepted due to lack of volunteer opportunities



VOLUNTEER PROGRAM

New safety measurement in place:

- -Temperature taken before starting the volunteer shift on site
- -Conducting symptom survey
- -Mandating the mask wearing
- -Limiting volunteer numbers to control the crowd at the shelter

Currently open/available positions on site:

- -Pet Food delivery for Pet Foodbank clients
- -Data entry for Development team
- -Dog Walkers (1 volunteer per shift)
- -Cat kennel cleaning (1 volunteer per shift)

Virtual Volunteer Opportunities:












Fundraising


- Goal \$15 million
