



We placed **2,999** pets in their new loving homes. That is **1,834** dogs and **1,165** cats placed.



We performed **10,006** spay/neuter surgeries at our two low-cost spay/neuter clinics.



95 dogs and cats were sponsored by the Have a Heart fund to help cover the cost for specialized medical tests and treatments.



Our shelter veterinary team performed **3,100** medical intake exams.



Our Community Cats Program has enabled us to humanely trap, neuter or spay, and return (TNR) **1,828** community (unowned) cats.



Our Clinic Services team cared for **4,331** animals at HSC's Essential Care Services appointments. A total of **12,293** low-cost, high-quality vaccines were administered.



Our Working Cats Program rehomed **34** cats who were not suited to indoor life find "employment" and new homes.



HSC Volunteers donated **6,194** hours of their time. In addition, HSC iFosters cared for **1,517** animals in their homes.



We distributed **59,692** lbs of pet food through our Pet Food Bank to support **1,629** households in need.



HSC assisted the surrounding counties with **8** emergency cases where we helped save more than **158** animals.



We accepted **384** animals from owner surrenders and **2,467** animals from municipal shelters, including our community partner CMPD Animal Care & Control.



Our Behavior Management team taught **342** participants in behavior training classes.
